Generous and charming



The last winter appeared to be particularly hot and favored an early vinegrowth. We had frost only 8 times. Spring was characterized by high temperatures, but offset by fresh temperatures at night. Thus budburst only began around mid-March while remaining two weeks ahead of the usual cycle. April was very dry. In June, blooming got off to a great start, filling us with optimism for the future. From July, the Veraison seemed more disorganized: it started early and ended late, with changes of colors until after mid-August. Summer was really disappointing. Fortunately the weather became very nice from the 29th of August. And this incredible Indian summer settled down until the last day of October. September was one of the driest and hottest in the last century. Thanks to this wonderful weather conditions we were able to harvest at the appropriate pace. We could wait until the perfect level of maturity.

Grape harvest dates

- \bullet Merlot : from October 1st to 10 $^{\rm th}$
- Cabernet Sauvignon : from October 13th to 18th
- Cabernet Franc : October 18th

- 39 % Cabernet Sauvignon
- 1 % Cabernet Franc
