



## CHATEAU FOURCAS HOSTEN

*Vintage 2016*

### Exceptional due to its balance



This vintage distinguishes itself with rainfalls' record: the equivalent of 12 months of rainfall (more than 800mm) in only 6 months, between January and June. Thanks to a mild weather window in an appropriate timing, flowering occurred remarkably during the second week of June. A hot and dry summer built the 2016 vintage's identity: an aromatic vintage, with tannin-rich structure.

September & October were wonderful. Fruit development was perfect thanks to high temperatures and warm nights when it began to ripen; and cool weather and chilly nights at the end of the ripening period.

Harvesting spread over 18 days: a wonderful Indian summer enabled to reach optimal maturity for each plot, and ensured to obtain a wonderful fruit.

#### Grape harvest dates

- Merlot: from October 3<sup>rd</sup> to 15<sup>th</sup>
- Cabernet Sauvignon: from October 15<sup>th</sup> to 20<sup>th</sup>
- Cabernet Franc: October 17<sup>th</sup>

#### Blending

- 55 % Merlot
- 44 % Cabernet Sauvignon
- 1 % Cabernet Franc

- 33 % one-year barrels
- 29 % two-year barrels
